You start in the Bronze Members, and can work your way all the way up to the Diamond Members. Here is the criteria for getting into each Member Group:

- Bronze Members: 1-17 Stars, earns \$10 in class money
- Silver Members: 18-34 Stars, earns \$20 in class money
- Gold Members: 35-51 Stars, earns \$30 in class money
- Platinum Members: 52-68 Stars, earns \$40 in class money
- Diamond Members: 69-95 Stars, earns \$50 in class money
